Transportation and Storage of Donated Items

Transportation of donated items to the PSA Foundation Centennial Silent Auction at Niagara Falls during the PSA Annual Meeting July 20-23, 2008, will be the responsibility of the donor. Donated items which cannot be transported to the Annual Meeting will be shipped to the winning bidder by the donor at the expense of the buyer at the conclusion of the Silent Auction in July 2008. .

Silent Auction

All memorabilia will be individually numbered and an auction bid sheet will be created to place alongside the item at the auction. The highest bidder will be responsible for payment and collection of their item prior to the closing of the 2008 annual meeting (details to follow). The items donated to the PSA Foundation Silent Auction which are transported to the auction by the donor will be displayed during the PSA Centennial Meeting in a dedicated room near the Cyber Café for your review as you finalize the bids before the ***bidding deadline of 5:00 pm on July 22, 2008***
